Scope of Position;

The successful candidate should be ready to work for considerable lengths of time when required under minimum supervision.

Key Qualification:

- Must be a registered Civil Engineer with a Degree in Civil Engineering.
- A postgraduate qualification in Civil or Highway Engineering and experience in contract administration under FIDIC/PPRA conditions of Contract is an added advantage.
- Must have a minimum of ten (10) years of specific experience related to Road/Bridge Design and Construction.

- Must have served as a Project Manager/Resident Project Manager/ Regional Manager in an equivalent capacity on at least three (3) bituminous road construction of similar magnitude and complexity in the last 10 years.
- Must have a working experience of at least 3 years in Sub Sahara Countries.
- Proficiency in written and spoken English is mandatory.

- Postgraduate qualification in Pavement or Materials Engineering is an added advantage.
- She/He must have a minimum of Ten (10) years of specific experience in Pavement/Materials matters related to road works.
- She/He must have served in a similar capacity on at least two (2) road projects of similar magnitude and complexity in the Last 10 years.
